INTRODUCTION OF GALL STONE

Gallstones are hardened deposits of digestive fluid (mainly cholesterol or bilirubin) that form in the gallbladder — a small organ under the liver that stores bile. Gallstones can vary in size and may be as small as a grain of sand or as large as a golf ball. Some people have just one gallstone, while others may have many.

TYPES OF GALLSTONE: -

1. Cholesterol Gallstones Most common type.
Made mainly of hardened cholesterol.
Usually yellow-green in color.
2. Pigment Gallstones Smaller and darker.
Made of bilirubin (a substance produced from the breakdown of red blood cells).

CAUSES

1. Too much cholesterol in bile
2. Too much bilirubin
3. Incomplete emptying of the gallbladder
4. Genetic factors
5. Obesity or rapid weight loss
6. Pregnancy
7. Certain medical conditions (like liver disease or diabetes)

SYMPTOMS

Some people have no symptoms (called “silent” gallstones). When symptoms occur, they may include:

- Sudden and intense pain in the upper right abdomen or center of the abdomen
- Pain in the right shoulder or back
- Nausea or vomiting
- Indigestion or bloating
- Fever and chills (if gallstone causes infection or inflammation)

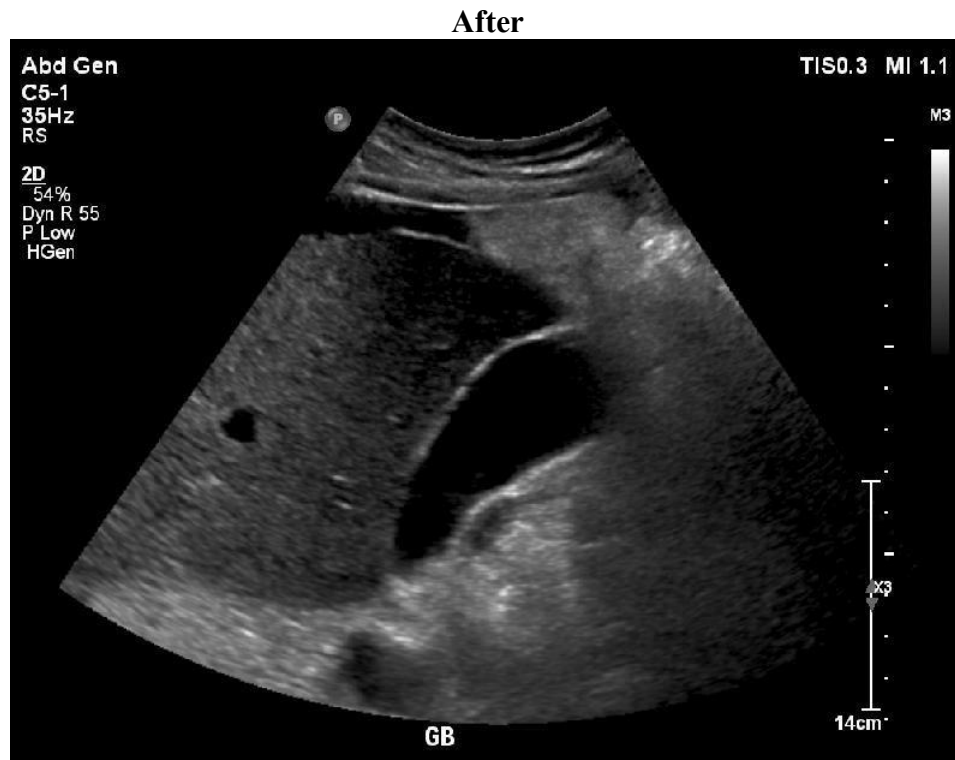
