(Garbh Sharir), 4.Laws of Genetics and their Role in Treatment of Genetic Disorders, 5.Rules of Homeostasis (Lok Purush concept), 6. Cadaveric and Systemic Anatomy, 7. Concept of Microcirculation (Srotovimanan) and their role in treatment of the diseases, 8. Concept of vital organ protection (Marma Vigyan), 9. DISCUSSION

Ayurveda, the ancient life science, believe on "Lok Purush Nyay" in which the composition of external and internal worlds are same, due to this statements every changes in external world (Lok) directly affects physio-anatomical aspect of internal world (Pusrush) in Ayurveda the metaphysical aspect of origin of sharir (Body), their establishment, destructuin and the concept of yoga is explained by this Lok Purush Nyay. This Lok Purush Nyay is the back bone of Ayurvedic way of treatment and at theorem level it is identical to homeostasis principal which is signature of vitality²¹.

The element of embryology and rules of genetics also seen in Ayurvedic text. The subjective embryological time length starts from preconceive management, gestational period management up to child birth management. The elemental genetic rules are also explained in ayurvedic texts surprise is very scientifically identical to modern genetics. If we clearly observed the whole genetic subjects in *Samhitas*, the genetic factors are divided into two sub types:

- 1. Main genetic material i.e. *Shukra* (Male gamete), *Shonit* (Female Gamete) and *Jiva* (the factor which controls the vitality of *Garbh* (Zygote), in which *Shukra* and *Shonit* have explained, the transmission of character from paternal and maternal side, is operated at *Beej* (Full genetic Material), *Beejbhag* (Chromosomal level), *Beejbhaagavayav* (Gene Locus Level), *Beejbhagavayav Purushkar* and *Strikarbhaav* (Gene Locus Determining the male and female characters)²². The genetic characters transmission which are not clearly explained for paternal and maternal side is explained by factor *Jiva* affected by *Purva Janmkrit Karma*, these transmitted characters are especial character follow special transmission pattern, now a days we can explained as specific environmental factors which controls gene regulation and remodeling.
- 2. The environmental factors which affects the embryonic period management.

Due to genetically explanation at two levels the genetic disorder and their management is explained at hereditary and congenital level in ayurvedic texts. At hereditary level several social rules (*Atulya Gotriya Vivaah*)²³ are formed to rectify personal and social hygiene helpful to stop the transmission of hereditary diseases and the congenital level several rule and regulation formed related to whole time length of embryonic period helpful to stop congenital disorder.

The another anatomical miracle is described in ayurvedic texts is, the explanation of *Sira*, *Dhamani* and *Srotas* Concepts as the internal transport system of the body. In modern medical texts the concepts of nanonism is depends on specific organ system Physio-Antomical aspect of micro circulation, the internal transport system of the body. In Ayurvedic texts again in *Sira*, *Dhamani* and *Srotas* subject topic is the differentiation and specification of organ system (*Pratyang*) of the body is explained for treatment point of view²⁴.

The cadaveric anatomy description is seen in *Garbha Sharir* (Embryology) where it is mention that the body is made up of six parts (2 Upper Limb, 2 Lower Limb, 1 Trunk, 1 Head and 1 Neck) where as systemic Anatomy description is seen in *Charak Samhita*.²⁵, In which the body parts, type and its number (Bone, Ligaments, Muscles Joints, Vital organ, Internal Organ, Senses Organ and Topographic division) is explained.

The structural and functional certification of the human body is well defined in *Samhitas* by *Angula Praman*²⁷ (Middle part of Middle Finger = 1 *Angula*) and *Anjali Praman*. In *Angula Pramn* the whole human body is measured by self *Angula* estimation, where as the liquid component of the body is measured by self *Anjali Praman*²⁶. In Samhita the statement is done, the healthiness of the body it depends on these *Pramana*, which Is helpful directional treatment point of view.

The regional Anatomy is also define in Samhita depends on topic which is scattered in whole Samhita and it is very identical to Modern Anatomy description.

The vital organ (Urinary Bladder, Heart and Head) protection in treatment is explained in *Charak Samhita*²⁰. very much identical to modern way of treatment in which few organs are categorized as vital organs. In accidental cases these organ should be protected firstly for saving of life.
