Homoeopathic Mother tinctures are used as supportive therapy in various surgical diseases to reduce inflammation, pain, infection and promote tissue healing. They are commonly applied in conditions such as hemorrhoids, fistula, gallstone, renal stone.

INTRODUCTION

A mother tincture is a liquid pharmaceutical preparation obtained by extracting the crude drug with alcohol by prescribed pharmacopoeial methods, and it forms the starting point for the preparation of homoeopathic potencies.

Use of Mother Tincture:

1. Used as the **starting material** for the preparation of homoeopathic potencies.
2. Used **therapeutically in low** doses in acute and chronic diseases.
3. Act **directly on organs and tissues**, producing physiological effects.
4. Some are used as **tonics and external application** as indicated.

STUDY

1. **Aesculus Hippocastanum** :Marked action on rectum -Haemorrhoids,dry aching in anus with sensations as if full of small sticks.Anus raw much pain after stool with prolapse of piles,blind and bleeding.Stool constipated;large,dry,hard.
2. **Allium Sativum**:A great anti-hypertensive.Hypertensive due to arteriosclerosis and hypercholesterolaemia.
3. **Chelidonium Majus** : A prominent liver remedy.Liver enlarged.Jaundice due to hepatic or gallbladder obstruction.Obstructive jaundice;stools,hard and clay coloured.Eye yellow.
4. **Cactus Grandiflorus** :Heart weakness due to arteriosclerosis.Tobacco heart.Violent palpitation;worse on left side and at approach of menses.Angina pectoris,with suffocation,cold sweat and the characteristic iron band feeling.pain in apex of heart,shooting down left arm.Endocarditis with mitral insufficiency.Ventricular enlargement.
5. **Digitalis** : A cardiac tonic-it stimulates heart's muscles,increases force and length of systole.All symptoms.organic heart disease;cardiac failure with auricular fibrillation.Rheumatic heart disorder, Ja-

- udice with heart disease.Mitral valvular disease.Pericarditis with effusion.
6. **Echinacea** : Septic condition;from boils to gangrene all benefitted by this great drug.Exophthalmic goitre.Snak bites and venom infections.Foul discharges and emaciation with great dwbility is a prominent feature.Recurrent boils.Carbuncles.Insect bites.Varicose ulcers.Bedsore.Gangrene etc.
 7. **Fel Tauri** : Disordered digestion.Diarrhoea and pain in nape of neck.Gall stone,obstructing bile duct.Billary colic,jaundice.
 8. **Hydrastis**:Ulcer and cancer of stomach.Gatritis.Liver torpid.Tender. Jaundice.Gall stone.Rectum,prolapsed,anal fissures.Constipation with sinking feeling in stomach and dull backache.During stool,smarting pain in rectum.After stool,long lasting pain.Haemorrhoids,even a light stool exhausts.Cervix eroded and excoriated.Leucorrhoea worse after menses and it is acrid and corroding,tenacious.Pruitis vulvae.Tumor of breas.,nipple retracted.
 9. **Ocimum Canum** :Right sided renal colic.Urine,turbid,thick,urulent,bloody,brick dust red or yellow sediment.Pain in ureters.
 10. **Ruta Graveoleus** : A very effective drug for the treatment of disturbances of accommodation in eyes.Cause of lower intestines.
